

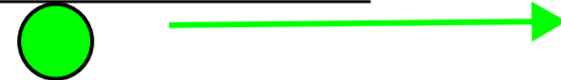

Gator Club Members



For Gator Club members who donate \$1200 (\$100/month) or more for the year please use the express line in green. You will have the ability to print out the annual forms from the website. If you have filled these out you will turn them in the room labeled in green on the map. If you have not filled out your forms you will have the opportunity in the room as there will be forms printed out for you. Once your forms are turned in you will be given a Gator Fund ticket with your forms stamped off. You will go to the K-8 Learning Center where you will meet your Section Head who will be handing out your child's schedule or homeroom teacher assignment. Once you are finished turning in your school supplies you may return to the Auxiliary Gym to address student services and socialize. 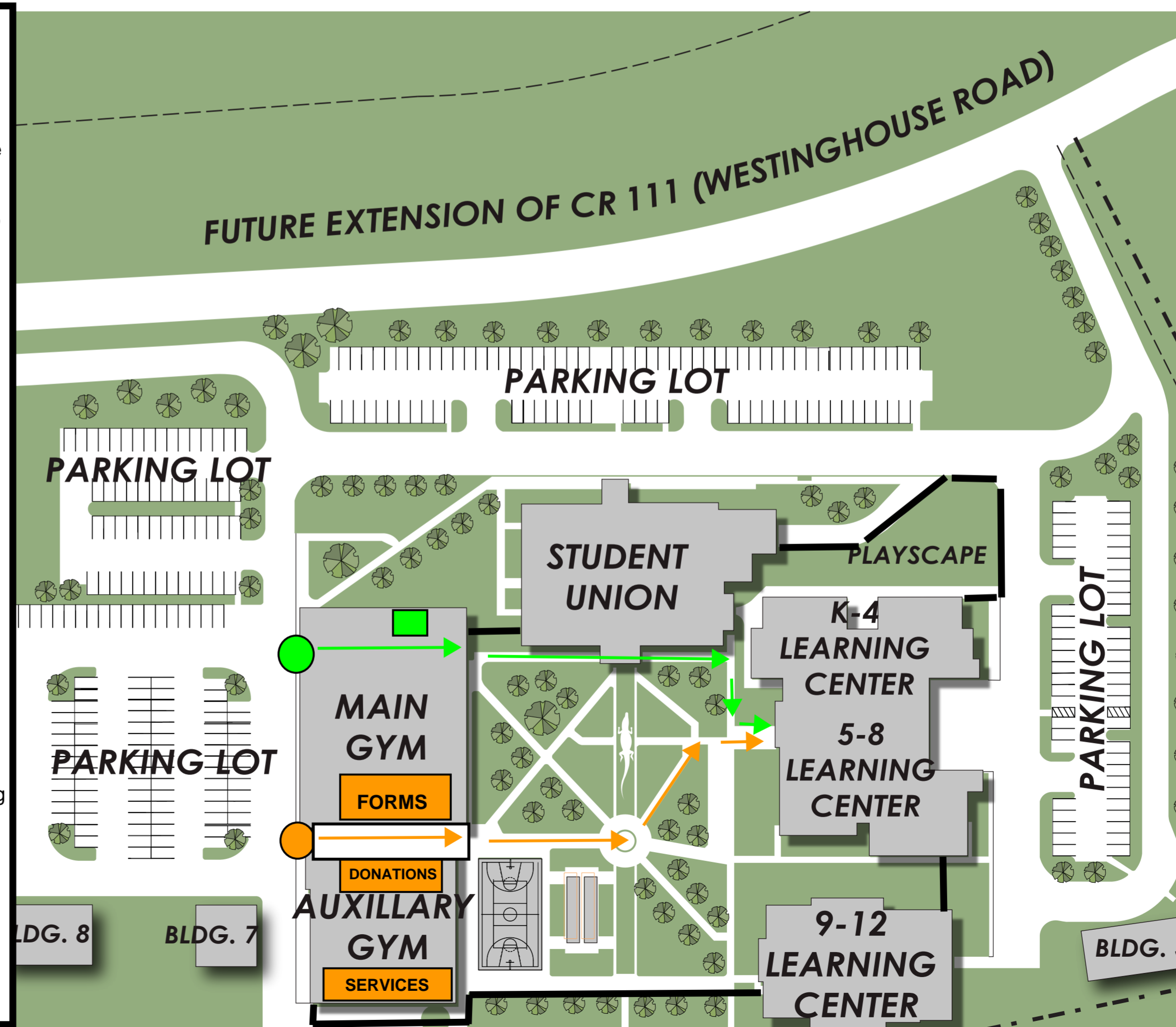
Non Gator Club Members



For non-gator club members please enter through the orange entrance to the gym foyer. New students to Gateway (Kinder and others who are attending Gateway for the first time) will be handed a sticker that will indicate that you have already turned in your forms and for people in student services to help you learn about what Gateway can offer you. All families entering the gym will receive a ticket that has two areas to get stamped. One section is for annual forms, and the other section is for voluntary donations. You can get these stamps in either order. The forms will be collected in the main gym. You have the ability to print out the forms before you get to Back 2 School Night to speed up the process. If you have not brought your forms to the event you may pick up packets from the big gym and fill out the forms in the bleachers. There will be front office staff in the big gym to verify that the forms are filled out correctly. If you are a new gator you need to get a stamp from one of the front office staff ensuring that you have already turned in your forms. Once you have turned in your forms in the big gym you will need to go in the auxiliary gym. You will need to see an Orenda staff member who will tell you about the benefits of donating to the Gator Fund. Remember, you can call Orenda at (512) 869-3020 and they can take your pledge for the year in order for you to gain access to the green express lane before the night begins to avoid lines. Once you have received a stamp from the Orenda Staff you can access Student Services in the gym including: nurse, after school care, PTO, food services, athletics, etc. Once you have received both your stamps you can go across the courtyard to the K-8 Learning Center where you will meet your Section Head who will be handing out your child's schedule or homeroom teacher assignment.

Other Important Information

All Learning Centers will be accessible from the courtyard. All exterior entrances will be locked except the gym entrances. Gates are now installed which will not allow access from the exterior of the campus. After you receive your schedule you may visit your teacher/s. Please limit your conversations to 10 minutes with the teacher. There will be opportunity to speak in greater detail with your child's teachers during open house in September. You may also drop off school supplies after you receive your schedule.
