FEE SCHEDULE*
2023-24

All Inclusive UIL Fee (UIL Athletics + Lacrosse, UIL Academic, & UIL Performing Arts Participation)

Grades 7 - 12 = **\$325** per student

UIL Academic & UIL Performing Arts ONLY Fee (for students who participate in academic and/or performing arts activities but not school sponsored athletics)

Grades 2 - 8 = **\$100** per student

Grades 9 - 12 = **\$180** per student

What it is:

- *The Texas University Interscholastic League (the "UIL") governs all Texas Public Schools extracurricular activities. Gateway Prep School is one of the few public charter schools in the Greater Austin area that offers UIL programs.*
- *UIL activities begin for all public schools in grade 7 and continue through grade 12.*
- *Extracurricular participation is voluntary but the fees are necessary if your child will be participating in any school athletic, academic, or performing arts activities.*
- *The All Inclusive UIL Fee covers participation in all extracurricular activities in grades 7 – 12 (this includes lacrosse participation in grades 7-12, although lacrosse is not UIL sanctioned. Lacrosse participates in the THSLL and CTYLL).*
- *The UIL Fee is due and payable upon registration.*

WAIVER FOR UIL FEES

When donations have been received for SY 2023-24 (or on a recurring donation plan to contribute at the minimum giving level or more during 2023-24 school year):

- **Gator 50/Supporter** (donating \$50 monthly or \$600 annually)- UIL fees waived for **one child**
- **Gator 100/Partner** (donating \$100 monthly or \$1200 annually) –UIL fees waived for **two children**
- **Gator 200/Golden Gate** (donating \$200 monthly or \$2400 annually) –UIL fees waived for **three children**
- **Gator 400/Mentor** (donating \$400 monthly or \$4800 annually) – UIL Fees waived for **four children**

Please Note:

- If you have paid the UIL fee, and your child does not end up participating in any UIL activity during the school year, your fee will be refunded to you.
- Your child cannot participate in the selected UIL activity until the fee is paid in full. Payments can be made on the Frontline Parent Portal (preferred method). Checks are also accepted – make check payable to **Orenda Education**.

What the UIL Fee covers:

- Helps to defray the costs of all athletic, academic, fine arts and music extracurricular activities and competitions. All of these programs have many costs, including facility usage fees, officiating fees, team practice and game

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uniforms, equipment, supplies, tournament and competition registration fees, team coach and activity sponsor stipends, travel costs, etc.

What the UIL Fee DOES NOT cover:

- 1) Lunches, snacks, including meals purchased by students while on UIL trips
- 2) Ownership of a computer or tablet device and other consumable school supplies
- 3) Admissions fees related to field trips and athletic competition spectator gate fees
- 4) Costs of participation in other school extracurricular activities such as dance, clubs, etc.
- 5) Items specific to classrooms at the elementary level (such as items for parties, special events, etc.)
- 6) Testing fees (AP, SAT, PSAT, etc.)
- 7) OnRamps Course Fee (\$149 per student per course)
- 8) Yearbook and other fees for items purchased and kept by the student
- 9) Athletics (non-UIL) for grades 6 & below

Non-UIL Extracurricular Participation Fees

Cheer – participation costs are **\$375 for MS** and **\$600 for HS** (fees do not include the cost for one-time cheer gear/supplies)

Dance – participation costs are **\$150** per elementary student, **\$300** per middle school student, and **\$400** per varsity student (fees do not include gear or camp costs)

Clubs (Robotics, KEY, FCA, NHS, etc.) - participation cost varies by club. Estimated to be less than **\$50** per student per club.

Food Services

Breakfast K-12: **\$2.00**

Lunch for Grades K-4: **\$4.00**

Lunch for Grades 5-12: **\$4.50**

Adult Lunch: **\$6.00**

A la carte prices vary by item for breakfast, lunch and snacks.

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
