Dear Gateway College Prep Community:

The schedules are now available in your Frontline Account (link click [HERE](#) or visit our website under the parent tab for links to parent logins). I have created a Google Slide presentation for how to log in and utilize the Frontline Parent Portal for your reference (Click [HERE](#)).

As a reminder, here is the schedule for Meet the Teacher Nights:

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Kinder Zoom with your homeroom teacher - 4:00pm - 5:00pm

1st Grade Zoom with your homeroom teacher - 5:00pm - 6:00pm

2nd Grade Zoom with your homeroom teacher - 6:00pm - 7:00pm

* Grades 5-12 will be recorded videos that will be available for you to watch on your schedule.

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3rd Grade Zoom with your homeroom teacher - 4:00pm - 5:00pm

4th Grade Zoom with your homeroom teacher - 5:00pm - 6:00pm

Juniors and seniors may see a "HOLD" period in their schedule. If you have a "HOLD" period, you are eligible to apply for an off period and/or aid period.

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Please know that schedules for students in grades 5-12 are subject to change due to balancing issues and last minute changes. We typically pass out a new schedule on the first day of school. Due to students not being on campus it is imperative that **students in grades 5-12 check their schedule again in Frontline on August 18th at 5pm to make sure you have the most up to date schedule.**

Also, Kinder students were assigned a homeroom teacher at random. The Kinder team normally does Bridge and Assessments before school starts to create class lists. We also do not have all the results back from the survey about how many Kinder students will choose the on-campus and remote options. Due to this we can't assign remote students to Andrea Mulvogue yet. This means that your homeroom teacher will most likely change after the first day of school. There will be communication from the Kinder team about this. Please attend the zoom session for your Kinder homeroom teacher that is currently assigned to learn more about the Kinder schedule and information.
